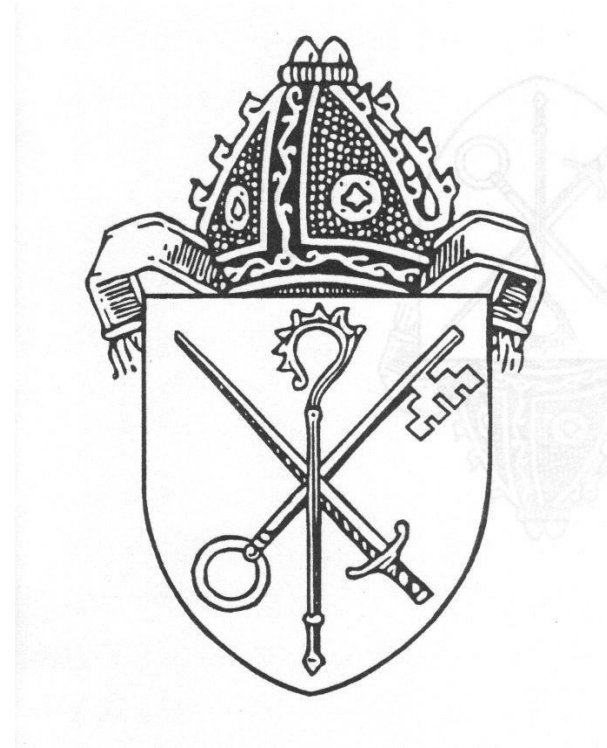

1. GATHERING IN GOD'S NAME (stand)

Opening hymn

The Lord be with you:

And also with you.

Grace, mercy and peace:

from God the Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.

Sentence of scripture.

Prayer of preparation:

**Almighty God, to whom all hearts are open,
all desires known, and from whom no secrets are hidden,
cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of your Holy Spirit,
that we may perfectly love you, and worthily magnify your holy name,
through Christ our Lord. Amen.**

Canticle: *The Lord's Servant*

He was despised, he was rejected:

A man of sorrows, acquainted with grief.

***As one from whom people hide their faces,
he was despised and we esteemed him not.***

Ours were the sufferings he bore:

Ours the torments he endured.

***While we thought he was being punished:
struck by God and brought low.***

He was pierced for our sins, bruised for no fault but ours.

His punishment has won our peace, and by his wounds we are healed.

***We had all strayed like sheep, all taking our own way,
but the Lord laid on him the guilt of us all.***

Make us to be one with you and share the life of your kingdom.

2. THE CONFESSION *(kneel)*

God shows his great love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Let us then confess our sins in penitence and faith:

(a time of silence)

For accepting life yet living it without you, forgive us Lord.

For living without concern for others, forgive us Lord.

For tolerating oppression, injustice and wrong, forgive us Lord.

For disobeying your will and commandments, forgive us Lord.

For turning the world to our own purposes and desires, forgive us Lord.

For refusing to love and forgive others, forgive us Lord.

For disfiguring this land and despoiling its bounty, forgive us Lord.

***For not listening to the griefs of others,
and taking away their self respect, forgive us Lord.***

For greed and impatience, for evading responsibility, forgive us Lord.

O God, we confess that we have sinned.

We turn to you,

we renounce evil,

we humbly claim your love,

and ask to be made whole.

This we pray through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Words of consolation and assurance:

If anyone sins, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. He is the perfect offering for our sins, and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world. (1John 2:1-2)

3. THE MINISTRY OF GOD'S WORD *(sit)*

First Bible reading.

Second Bible reading.

Hear the word of the Lord : Thanks be to God.

Hymn.

Gospel reading.

The gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ, according to

Glory to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

This is the Gospel of the Lord :

Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

The sermon.

The Apostle's creed:

***I believe in God, the Father almighty,
creator of heaven and earth.***

***I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord,
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,
born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate,
was crucified, died, and was buried;
he descended to the dead.
On the third day he rose from the dead;
he ascended into heaven,
and is seated at the right hand of the Father;
from there he will come to judge the living and the dead.***

***I believe in the Holy Spirit,
the holy catholic Church,
the communion of saints,
the forgiveness of sins
the resurrection of the body,
and the life everlasting. Amen.***

4. THE GREETING OF PEACE & OFFERING *(stand)*
