

RECOMMENDED SETTINGS OF THE EUCHARIST SUITABLE FOR CONGREGATIONAL USE

Compiled by the National Ecumenical Church Music Committee, December 2007

These are settings that could be sung by congregations without choirs. In general the tune does not range too widely. The difficulty of each setting is indicated.

Title: including list of performers (eg organ/piano/other instrumental/ cantor/singing celebrant/ optional mixed or equal choir), parts included (K = Kyrie, G = Gloria, GA = Gospel Acclamation, S = Sanctus, B = Benedictus, A = Agnus Dei) and publisher (or, if unpublished, contact details of composer)

Annotations: CS (congregational standard) = Easy, Moderate
 ChS (choir standard) = Easy, Moderate, Difficult
 A (accompaniment) = Easy, Moderate, Difficult
 C (congregational part duplicated in accompaniment) = yes/no
 Audio (available on tape/CD?)
 E = Eucharistic prayer sung
